

# Range FAQ

#### Who can use the range and what is the cost?

To use our range you need to be one of the following:

- VFW Member (If you are a Veteran and served overseas in a war zone, you can join the VFW)
- VFW Auxiliary Member (Auxiliary membership is open to a child, grandchild, parent, grandparent, sibling or spouse of any Veteran who is eligible to join the VFW)
- Friends of the Post (FOTP) 2801 Member status available to most.
  - Above memberships vary in application costs and any of the above can shoot on our Post range for \$10 per hr. Our members family is covered under their membership, so a Post member souse or significant other, their children under 26 still living at home, grandchildren under 18 all shoot at the member rate.
- Any of our members can bring a guest that guest will pay \$20

## Facts of the range?

- Length is 0 50 ft or anything in between. It is NRA compliant for NRA Matches
- Using state of the art computer controlled target systems
- Our air exchange is excellent Air is changed every 60 -90 seconds providing our shooters with a quality environment.
- Heated and air conditioned

## What calibers can I shoot at the VFW range?

- You can shoot any firearm using common centerfire pistol cartridge
- You can shoot rimfire .22 ammunition
- NO shooting of high power rifle cartridges or any center-fire hollow points.

- Our RSO (Range Safety Officers) will be on the range anytime it is open. Having only 5 lanes to oversee, they offer excellent supervision and have to ability to assist on safe gun handing practices.
- This is a private range, it is a privilege to shoot here, and we hold our members to a specific standard of safe behaviors.
- Working towards attaining VFW RSO status will be encouraged.
